Overall leader in the Handicap is still Alison, with 48 pts ahead of Nathan Graham in second, 46pts and Greg on 39pts. Getting a wee bit closer at the top. With 4 runs to go, Nathan has now scored in all 8 of the first 8 runs and Alison in 7 so plenty could change yet as only the best 8 scores count at the end of the season.
