Club Standards are based on age-graded tables published by World Masters Athletics, which compare performances to global best times across different age groups in both road and track events.

Performance Categories:

- Platinum
- Gold
- Silver
- Bronze
- Copper

To qualify for an annual club standard, you must record times in three different distances, one of which must be 10K or longer, on an accurately measured course (including club race nights).

To submit your claim, provide your age, race title, and supporting evidence for all 3 races to Lisa Allan, last counting race, Fraserburgh Half.
